INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

According to the art. 13 of the European Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter GDPR or General Data Protection Regulation) and in relation to personal data of which the International Association New Humanity NGO will become available following your request to participate in activities from the Greenclusive Project in presence and/or online, we inform you of the following:

Data controller and responsible for the protection of personal data

The data controller is the International Association NEW HUMANITY NGO, registered office in Via Piave, 15 00046 Grottaferrata, (Rome) Italy, info@new-humanity.org, +39.06-94315635, in the person of the President Mr. Marco Desalvo.

1. Personal data processing operations and related purposes

We summarize below all the operations we perform that involve the collection, storage or processing of your personal data and the purposes we pursue with each of them:

- a) to allow the publication of texts and images relating to your participation in the Milonga program;
- b) to guarantee the fulfillment of the various bureaucratic-administrative practices related to the program.

2. Legal basis of the processing

The treatments and purposes indicated above are made legitimate by the express consent of the interested party, with the exception of treatments imposed by law for which consent is not required.

3. Processing methods

Your personal data may be processed both through paper and computer files (including portable devices) and in strictly necessary ways to meet the aforementioned purposes. All data processing operations are carried out in such a way as to guarantee their integrity and confidentiality.

4. Data retention period

In compliance with the provisions of art. 5 of the GDPR, the personal data collected will be stored in a form that allows the identification of data subjects for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which the personal data are processed.

5. To whom can your data be communicated?

- 5.1 The data provided may be made available to employees working within the International Association New Humanity NGO (contacts, collaborators, employees, people in charge of processing the data within the scope of their duties).
- 5.2. Your data could be communicated to subjects, institutions or authorities to whom the disclosure of data is required by law.
- 5.3. Your data can be sent to the subjects, who regularly collaborate with the activities of the International Association New Humanity NGO such as the Focolare Movement (its civil bodies)

PAFOM and PAMOM), Youth for a United World Movement and the New Humanity Movement and the regional NGOs partners of Milonga.

As an interested party, you have the opportunity to exercise all the rights recognized and guaranteed by the current legislation regarding the processing activities concerning your personal data towards the International Association New Humanity NGO. In accordance with the provisions of the GDPR you have the right:

- a) to obtain at any time the confirmation of the existence or not of a treatment of personal data concerning you and, if so, to gain access to personal data as well as information on the categories of personal data processed, on the recipients or the categories of recipients to whom the personal data are or will be communicated;
- b) to request the rectification of inaccurate personal data, the integration of incomplete data or the limitation of the processing that concerns them or to oppose their treatment;
- c) to propose a complaint to the Guarantor for the protection of personal data or to the competent Authority which is that of the place of habitual residence or domicile of who disputes a violation of their rights, following the procedures and indications published on the official website of the Authority on www.garanteprivacy.it;
- d) to request the immediate deletion of the personal data concerning you when the consent is revoked, are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or processed, the legal basis for the treatment has ceased, have been unlawfully processed;
- e) "data portability": the GDPR introduces the new right to data portability. This right allows the data subject to receive his/her personal data in a structured format, commonly used and readable by an automatic device, and under certain conditions - to transmit them to another data controller without hindrance. Only personal data that (a) relates to the interested party, and (b) has been provided by the data subject; (c) whose processing is based exclusively on a contract or the consent of the person concerned; (d) the data is processed only with the aid of electronic means (paper archives and manual data processing are excluded from portability) is portable.
